In July 2018, Japan was devastated by the worst natural disaster since the 2011 earthquake and tsunami. Pensacola's sister city, Gero, experienced flooding and landslides that damaged roads and buildings.

Our relationship with Gero (formerly called Hagiwara) goes back 25 years. In addition to participating in hundreds of middle school exchanges and establishing friendships with Pensacolians, the citizens of Gero have stepped up after both Hurricane Ivan in 2004 and the floods in 2014 to offer assistance to Pensacola.
